


Intellectual Property Industrial Designs?

- Proof of Ownership (Sketches)

















Q2: Economic Impact of Intellectual Property



- (IP) contributes enormously to the national economy
- Valuable business asset
- Creates and Supports High-Paying Jobs
- Protection of IP is considered an investment
- Enhancement of the competitiveness
- Strong and Enforced Intellectual Property Rights protects Consumers and Families
- Consumers use IP to ensure they are purchasing safe, guaranteed products
- Intellectual Property Rights encourage Innovation and Reward Entrepreneurs
- Intellectual property worth over 27 million jobs, \$5.6 trillion to US economy




How much is a Painting worth?

This painting was painted by Jackson Pollock in 1948. David Geffen sold this painting to David Martinez in 2006.





How much is a TM worth?


A brand could be worth as much as 80% of the overall value of the business.








What should SMEs Do?

Anti-Counterfeiting Ingredients?




- Have a Strategy
- Protect your IP Rights by registering them
- Build relationship through Public Private Partnership
- Conduct extensive Market Surveys & Monitoring in relation to the most affected brands
- Target all distribution channels at the same time (Manufacturers, Importers, Distributors, Pharmacies, Shops,...).
- Immediate Administrative & Legal Actions against all infringers (no matter the quantities involved)
- 0% tolerance plan towards the infringers.





