Workshop on the IFRS 16 Leases Wednesday August 21, 2019 11.00 am – 6.00 pm

About the workshop:

IFRS 16 represents the first overhaul of lease accounting for over three decades. The IASB has long considered the existing split between operating and finance leases as problematic as it has resulted in too much structuring and off-balance sheet financing. The new standard will have an impact on all organizations, particularly those with major assets under operating leases.
